- Family Issues
  - Marriage rates continue to decline.
  - Most annulments or divorces occur between1 and 8 years of marriage.
  - -Child abuse and family assessment rates increased from 17 per 1000 (1995) to 45 per 1000 (2004).
  - -1 of every 18 youth in Missouri is raised by a grandparent.

# Human Environmental Sciences Emerging Issues

- Nutrition, Health & Physical Activity
  - -Missouri is the 7<sup>th</sup> most sedentary state.
  - -Missouri is the 10<sup>th</sup> most obese state.
- Financial Support and Well-being
  - -In 2000, 637,891 Missourians lived in poverty.
  - In 2006, 789,262 Missourians participated in the Food Stamp Program.
